4 (a) To obtain services from the Library for the Blind and Physically Handicapped, Accessible Books and Library 5 Services, users shall submit an application to the Library, 1841 Capital Boulevard, Raleigh, North Carolina 27635. 6 Applications shall be submitted on a form prepared by the Library and include the user's: 7 name, address, and telephone number; (1)8 (2)-county of residence; 9 (3)date of birth: 10 (4)gender; applicant's basic facts, such as applicant name and contact information; name, address, and telephone number of a friend or relative; an alternative contact; 11 (5) 12 (6) status as an honorably discharged veteran of the Armed Forces of the United States; States 13 military; qualifying disability including: 14 (7) 15 (A) blindness; (B) visual handicap; 16 (C) physical handicap; 17 (D) reading disability; or 18 19 (E) deaf and blind; disability; 20 (8) degree of hearing impairment of either: (A) moderate some difficulty understanding speech; or 21 22 (B) profound cannot hear or understand speech; impairment, if any; 23 (9) preferred items such as books recorded on digital cartridge with digital player, braille books, large 24 print books, or music; 25 (10)necessity for special attachments such as headphones, amplifier, breath switch, or remote control; 26 (11)language preference; service preference such as: 27 (12)(A) requested materials only; or 28 29 (B) materials requested by the Library based upon selected reading preferences; (13) reading preferences such as Fiction, Non Fiction, Adventure, Aging/Retirement, Animal Stories, 30 31 Arts, Best Sellers, Biography, Black Literature, Technology/Computers, Classics, Cooking/Homemaking, Current Events, Disabilities, Family Stories, Fantasy, Folklore/Fairy 32 Tales, General Fiction, Health/Medicine, Historical Fiction, History US, History World, Humor, 33 Marriage/Family, Mysteries, Nature, North Carolina, Occult/Horror, Plays, Poetry, 34 Politics/Government, Psychology, Religious Inspiration, Religion (scholarly), Romance, Science, 35 Science Fiction, Sea Stories, Short Stories, Sports, Spy Stories, Business, Travel, War Stories, or 36 37 Western; and

- 1 (14) reading restrictions such as strong language, violence, or explicit descriptions of sex.language, 2 reading and service delivery method preferences. 3 (b) Applications shall be certified by a competent authorityan individual authorized under 36 CFR 701.6 to certify an applicant's eligibility and shall include the competent authority's certifying individual's name, address and 4 5 telephone number, title and occupation, and an original signature.
